## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE BY CATHIE SMITH

I do hope this finds you all well and settling into the flow of the New Year. I think we are all more than ready for March to come in like a lamb and not like a lion.

Our ingathering for our February show at the Faulkner drew an excellent response. We had 126 entries and our Juror, Nina Warner from SBCC, selected 72 pieces to be displayed. The First Place went to Margaret Singer, Second Place to Nancy Lynch, and Third Place to me! Honorable mentions went to Jerry Martin, Beverly Decker, and Edward Rodgers. We also presented two Memorial Awards in honor of members we have lost; to Sally Hamilton to honor Caroline Mairani and to Bob Trimble in honor of David Crouch. Our First Thursday reception was very well attended considering we only have 2 hours now to meet and greet. This was a very enjoyable evening for me as it was also the opening of my solo show in the Faulkner East Wing.

Saturday, February 10<sup>th</sup> was the show exchange at 1919 State. The Juror was Ditte Wolf and of 46 entries, 43 were selected. First Place went to **Loren Nibbe**, second Place to **Kristine Kelly**, and Third to **Louise Komp**. Honorable Mentions went to **Christine Flannery**, **Louise Komp**, and **Ronald Abeles**.

We have 2 special events in March. The ingathering for the **Santa Barbara International Orchid Show** will be **Wednesday**, **March 7**<sup>th</sup> **from 10-1**. This show is open to all artists and all submissions that meet the criteria of orchid representation will be accepted. The award win-

ners will be chosen by Chris Chapman. Full details are on the Orchid Show website listed on page one.

Monday, March 19<sup>th</sup> is our semi-annual ingathering for New Members at the Faulkner Gallery from 10-12:30. Invite all your artistic friends to consider joining SBAA and remember that membership opens up entry to our SBAA shows and also the opportunity to show at Gallery 113.

We are still dealing with some issues regarding the pickup of artwork after a show, particularly at 1919 State and the Hutton where shows go out and come in on the same day. Pickup of art at these two venues, as it is at all our shows, is a FIRM 10-12, no exceptions. All old art must be cleared off the walls before the new show can be hung and having new and old art only leads to confusion and more work for our volunteers who operate the shows. They do not want to wait around for you to show up and they most especially do not want to have to lug your work home with them. Pieces not picked up on time from any of our venues will result in your not being allowed to enter the next Faulkner show.

Finally, a gracious offer from a group in New York City called ARTISTS' FELLOWSHIP, INC. whose mission it is to help artists who have experienced losses due to natural disasters. Each piece must have a wire from which to hang (no sawtooths). No shrink wrapped pieces accepted, all pieces must be framed or finished canvas edges. 35% commission goes to SBIOS for handling the sale. Local growers are happy to welcome artists to come and paint or photograph their orchids.
