PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE BY CATHIE SMITH

How can this possibly be the last of 72 letters ... and yet it is.

I want you all to know how much I have enjoyed being the President of the SBAA and how much I will continue to enjoy my participation in this wonderful organization. The rewards have been plentiful and the friends I've made have really enhanced my life! I know that Nancy Hull will do an excellent job for us all so, please give her and the Board, your support in any way you can. If everyone helps a bit, it will improve everyone's experience. I have also been very fortunate to have, as my not-so-secret weapon, Jacqui Bravo. Her keen mind and organizational skills have kept me and the SBAA on track. It has been my pleasure to serve and thank you everyone for your support!

Saturday, April 28th was our Annual General Meeting, held this year at the Fess Parker (now the Hilton) resort on East Cabrillo Boulevard. Scholarships were awarded to art students from SBCC, UCSB, and Westmont College. Volunteer of the year award went to **Bob Trimble** and New Member of the year award went to Julianne Martin. The atmosphere was lovely and the food delicious but the attendance was extremely disappointing. The question in my mind is why so few members of SBAA chose not to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to socialize with fellow artists? With your membership renewal forms, you will each receive a questionnaire regarding your opinions about the SBAA. Please take the time to fill it out and return it – you can return it anonymously if you choose – but tell us what you think.

As some of you may know, the season of giving came early this year. Two weeks before the end of April, the SBAA was offered and accepted 3 additional months at the Faulkner gallery – May (currently up), July, and September. We already had June and December. Please read the emails you will receive (or the newsletters) very carefully, as there

will be some different days and times for ingatherings and take-downs. The current show at the Faulkner was juried by John Carlander who chose 77 works from the 121 entries. First Place went to Susan Drake, 2nd to Rodger Dawson, and 3rd to Ann Raleigh with Honorable Mentions to Danuta Bennett, Nancy Freeman, and Ron Abeles. Katie Fagan won the Audree Campbell Memorial Award and Marie Arnold the John Moses Memorial Award. There is also a show in the East Gallery of New Members who joined in March. The New Members show comes down on May 31st from 10-12 and the Faulkner May show comes down on June 4 from 10-12 while the June show is being ingathered from 10-12:30.

The latest 1919 State Street show changed on Saturday, May 12. Gary Brown was the juror and out of 43 entries, he selected 36. First Place went to **Colin Schildhauer**, Second Place went to **Ron Abeles** and Third Place to **Kate Eden**. Honorable Mentions went to **Nancy Freeman**, **Frances Reighley and Cathie Smith**. The next 1919 show opportunity will be August 11th.
