SBAA's busy spring kicked off with The Art and Photography Show, at the Santa Barbara International Orchid Show, the only themed show this year managed by SBAA. The ingathering was the visual feast that we've come to expect over the years. Being in the midst of thousands of blooming orchids and the exhibits

under construction, while enjoying the orchid-themed art as it is entered, is always a treat. Our juror this year, Ray Hunter, awarded first place to David Holt (deceased former SBAA member) for *Star Orchids* that his widow submitted, second to **Gail McBride Kenny** for *A Chorus Line*, and third to **Heisoon Haan** for *Heart of Orchid*. **Martha Shilliday** and **Francine McOwen** received Honorable Mentions. There were 60 entries, of which 55 were accepted.

Monday, March 25 will be the next opportunity for your artist friends and acquaintances to apply for membership in the SBAA. As usual, jurying will take place at the Faulkner, BUT now the window is from 10—12. We hope that by trimming a half hour off the entry window, we'll be able to finish jurying and cross-checking on time, preventing a long wait outside the gallery before receiving results.

I look forward to seeing you at the Annual Celebration on Sunday, April 14 at the Glenn Annie Golf Course! This is our one yearly opportunity to come together and thank our volunteers, celebrate a year of fabulous shows and award winners, and welcome our newer members. There will be time to socialize before lunch from 11:30—12 and also to grab a glass of wine or a pint should you wish, and even a chance for a little collaborative art, if you want to participate.
