# President's Message by Nancy Hull



In spite of Fiesta traffic downtown and the unusual time for our event, the August 1 ingathering for the Faulkner show had 83 submissions. The juror, Martha Donelan, selected 75 for the show and bestowed the following awards: first place went to **Roger Dawson** for his photograph *Yosemite* 

er Dawson for his photograph Yosemite Fall; Lynn Humphrey received 2<sup>nd</sup> for her pastel titled Daydreams; 3<sup>rd</sup> went to Sophia Beccue for her acrylic Hope; and honorable mentions went to Frances Reighley, Marcia Morehart and Michael LaPuma. I'm grateful to all the volunteers who helped shoehorn this ingathering into a rather narrow window, to Roger Balabanow for hanging the show, and to all who braved the Fiesta turmoil to participate and again to pick up your declined pieces that afternoon.

There was also good participation on August 10 at 1919 State, with 67 entries. The juror, Ralph Waterhouse, who kindly stepped in at the last minute for Lynn Holly, selected 47 for this popular show and made the following awards: 1<sup>st</sup> place went to **Frances Reighley** for her oil painting *Cousin Joe*; **John Williams** received 2<sup>nd</sup> place for his oil painting *Solitude Eastern Sierra*, and 3<sup>rd</sup> was awarded to **Nancy Yaki** for her acrylic *Late Harvest*. Honorable mentions went to **Ron Abeles**, **Jerilynne Nibbe** and **Alyssa Beccue**. Thanks are due to Frances Reighley, Bob Trimble, Louise Komp, and Jennifer Ringer for managing this show and to Michael Mead for hanging it.

When setting up for a 1919 State ingathering, one of the first steps is to make an inventory of the old show indicating where each piece was hung; this allows us to direct people who are retrieving artwork and hopefully eliminates their search of all three floors. This month, the inventory came up short several pieces, leaving the volunteers wondering if they had been sold, removed for another show, or stolen. *Please do not do this to our volunteers.* If you sell something before the end of the show, please let us know (my number that is on the reminder card 805-455-4381 or call our SBAA general contact number 805-963-1026). And, please plan ahead so that you don't have to remove work from one show to put in another.

Our last show in August is at the Jewish Community Center, **ingathering on August 22**, and I hope you'll all be able to participate and also attend the reception provided, which is always a very enjoyable event. Remember, **we can accept 100 pieces at this venue!** Looking farther ahead, we're coming up on our next opportunity for artists who would like to join SBAA, to be juried in. If you have artist friends who would be interested, please let them know that September 16 is

the big day. More information is available on our website, and there are flyers available in Gallery 113 and on the front desk in the Faulkner.

Bill Hull is the final board member to be introduced. For years, he's been our juror selector, and more recently he has been helping me manage the ingatherings, including securing room and gallery reservations and getting the printing for them done.



I have enjoyed creating art since 1970 and have been a lover of nature since a child. Born in Mt. Kisco, N.Y., I graduated from Chaffey College in Rancho Cucamonga, CA. with a degree in art and biology/premed in 1963 and then served as a medic in the U.S. Army in Korea between 1963-1965. Following my discharge, I worked in the biology department at SBCC for 32 years, and during that time, I began taking classes there through the (now) CCL program, focusing on plein air oil painting, stained glass, drawing, botanical illustration, and watercolor.

Lately, my focus has shifted to taking workshops, especially when there is an opportunity to travel, too. After being juried into the SBAA, I offered to help as a board member; currently I select jurors and help at ingatherings, occasionally help with hanging the smaller shows, and mainly do whatever I can to help Nancy with managing the shows.

In addition to SBAA, I'm a member of the Mesa Artists Studio Tour and S.C.A.P.E.


