CONGRATULATIONS!

Linda Mutti was awarded second place in the Red Rock Pastel Society of Nevada's member show.

Betsy Gallery was interviewed by Rick Steves on his radio show Travel with Rick Steves on Sunday, May 23. www.ricksteves.com/radio Betsy told listeners about London's Queenhithe Dock Mosaic which inspired her project, the Santa Barbara Timeline Mosaic: 150 million years of history in 50 feet of mosaic. Betsy and Robin Elander, project manager (now executive director of Downtown Santa Barbara), were meeting with potential site developers for the mosaic when the pandemic put a hold on everything. On the link to the radio show are links to both Betsy's project and the Queenhithe Dock Mosaic, which tells the story of the creation of London by the Romans to now. David Tootill, principal of the London School of Mosaics created the mosaic along the Thames River. https://www.lsomosaic.com/ His school offers short weekend classes as well as longterm career programs. Betsy and Robin will re-start the SB Timeline Mosaic when conditions allow.

Betsy Gallery completed a family memorial mosaic which she delivered to her client on Memorial Day. The 24 square foot boulder mosaic commemorated her father's work as an architect, depicting elements of a mosaic created years ago on the grounds of the hospital her father designed. The base for the mosaic is a fiberglass boulder. Contours on the boulder created challenges requiring some very tiny pieces. The mosaic took 275 hours to complete.

Jo Merit was awarded Honorable Mention for her painting A Brief Conversation in the Westmont-Ridley Tree Museum of Art tri-county juried exhibition, At the Edges. The show can be viewed live at the museum through June 19, or online at www.westmont.edu/juriedshow

On July 15, Gallery 113 will open wall scheduling for 2022. Artists who want to reserve a Featured Artist wall in 2022 can submit their name, month, and wall. These reservations are for the 2 Small Walls on the first floor and the 4 Mezzanine Walls.

After the first round of reservations, artists can submit for a second wall on **August 15**.

Artists may have up to three (3) shows per year in any combination of Mezzanine and Small Image spaces, but no more than two (2) Small Image Shows, one of which may be reserved starting on July 15 and a second starting on August 15, if space is available.

Artists can rent spaces as a group (e.g., any number of artists can rent the mezzanine for a group show) however, for any artists participating, that counts as a show of the three allowed above. The email for submissions is gallery 113 wallspace@gmail.com
