# VICE PRESIDENT NANCY HULL'S MESSAGE

On Tuesday, November 2, SBAA members entered 101 pieces, of which juror Patricia Chidlaw selected 80 for our November show at the Faulkner Gallery. Lawrence Wallin was awarded 1st Place for his acrylic landscape titled Morning Fog. Nancy Freeman's oil painting Palm Shadow was selected for 2<sup>nd</sup> Place, and Sally Berry earned the 3<sup>rd</sup> Place ribbon for her photograph Moody Blues. Honorable Mentions went to Denise Carey, Barbara Hershberg. and Jeff Brent, while the Bill Poehler memorial award was awarded to Susan Drake for her photo Roadside, Navajo Nation. Congratulations to all of you who had work selected for this exciting and diverse show. Please thank the volunteers -Ron Abeles, Jacqui Bravo, Lori Call, Jewell De-Moss, Jim Felland, Alison Frost, Patti Post, Cathie Smith, Brian Tepper and show hanger extraordinaire Roger Balabanow. - who worked to get the entries processed, the show hung, and the labels placed by the following mid-morning.

Our quarterly show at 1919 State changed out on Saturday, November 12. Of the 61 entries, juror Natalie Sanderson selected 51 and made the follow-

ing awards: 1<sup>st</sup> Place to **Bill Banning** for his photograph *Return to Freedom*, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place to **Bill Hull** for his oil painting *The Gap*, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place to **Stephen Sherrill** for his photograph *Prague Castle*; Honorable Mentions were awarded to **Carol Ondry**, **Lizabeth Madal**, and **Dierdre Stietzel**.
