At the November 4 show change at 1919 State, there were 68 entries, of which juror Nancy Caponi selected 51. Congratulations to **Glen Serbin**, who received the 1st place ribbon for Aquarium, a photograph on Aluminum. The 2nd place ribbon was awarded to **Frances Reighley** for Go With the Flow, Take 2, an oil on canvas, and **Sophia Beccue** received 3rd place for Fall Delight, a watercolor on paper. **Terrance Wimmer, Andie Adler, Shelby Harbison, and Elizabeth Imperato** were each awarded Honorable Mention ribbons. It was great to see so many of our newest members participating in this show! Please note that most of the 17 pieces that were declined were on account of limited wall space, which is the case for all our juried shows. However, please remember that for all SBAA shows, 2-dimensional art – whether photography, assemblage, fabric or any other wall art - MUST BE WIRED in order to make the hanging as quick and easy as possible for the volunteers doing the show installation.

Thank you all who submitted art and who retrieved from the previous show on time. And a special thanks to the volunteers who managed the ingathering – Mary Kelly, Louise Komp, Matt Lancaster, Fred Lehto, Glen Serbin, and Terry Wimmer.

On **Friday, December 1**, we will have the ingathering for our annual non-juried holiday show. Entries are limited to 3 per artist and must be priced at \$500 or less (or NFS). It was difficult to select a publicity image for the show from all the wonderful art you sent in; thank you for your submissions. The image chosen, was **Lawrence Wallin's** June Lake in December. We hope you enjoy our festive holiday show and hope you attend our reception on Thursday, December 7 from 5 - 8.




