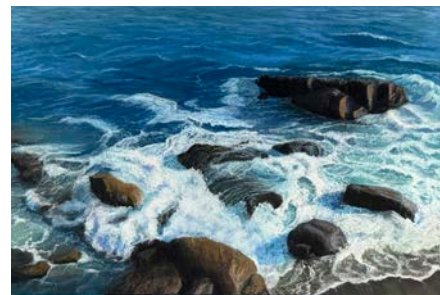

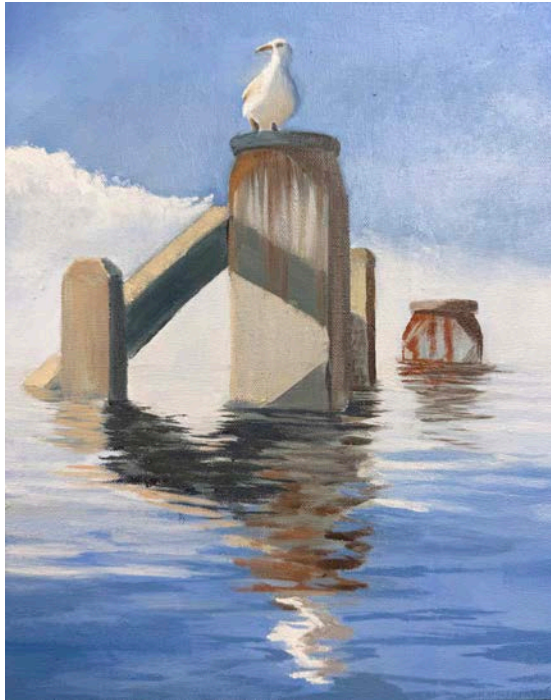
Carol Talley will be teaching a 2-day workshop in Medford, OR on **Sept. 19 & 20, 2026**
